

Dear Friends of Helping Hands,

We hope you and your families are well and want to update you on Helping Hands Outreach. The support from our communities of Holdingford, Saint Stephen, Saint Wendel, Saint Anna, Saint Francis, Saint Anthony and Opole enables us to continue to help our area senior citizens and adults with disabilities to stay in their homes.

Our major summer fundraiser has always been a raffle and bake sale during Holdingford Daze, which has now been cancelled. This year with Covid-19, we also did not want to ask our local businesses for raffle prizes.

We are asking you for your help in supporting us with a fundraiser called Give65. It takes place July 14 – 18, and Home Instead Senior Foundation will be matching donations up to \$5,000 until they have given away their matching funds of \$125,000 (which usually happens the first day). As we have done for our annual appeal, checks that we receive in the office by July 13th will be submitted for the matching amount. Our goal is to raise \$5,000 with the matching \$5,000 for a total of \$10,000. Go to www.give65.org, click on the "Donate" tab, write in Helping Hands Outreach, and click to our donation site. If you are uncomfortable with donating online, you can send a check to the office, and we will apply it for you. Please put "Give65" on the check memo.

Due to Covid-19, much of our work has changed in the past few months. We are still providing services such as giving rides to doctor appointments and buying and delivering groceries, "Thinking of You" care packages, and treats. We have started cooking our weekly meal again in Holdingford, with some people picking up their meals and the staff delivering others. We also have had two free produce pickups in Holdingford, providing fresh potatoes, cabbage, onions, and apples to anyone who wanted them.

Covid-19 has prevented us from having weekly exercise classes, meals, monthly lunch and learn, and planning new ongoing activities. Once the governor's restrictions have lifted, we are excited to be able to offer group activities and a place for seniors to just hang out and enjoy a cup of coffee and refreshments. This will take place at our new home located at 531 Main Street, Holdingford, the site of the former Adult Day Center.

Whether you support us year-round or annually, your help is important and appreciated. Your donations are used locally to help your neighbors; this makes our communities places where seniors can live and contribute. The reality is that when we achieve this, everyone benefits.

It's just for love of fellow-man,


It's just to lend a helping hand.
